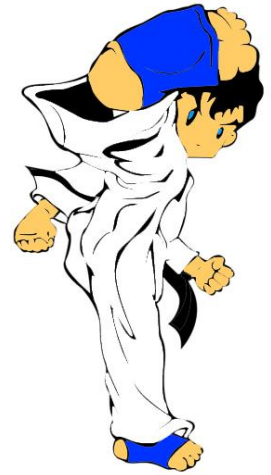

A spectator must never enter the matted area unless requested.

Do not question the judgement of and show your appreciation to all officials, helpers.

Condemn the use of violence or verbal abuse in all forms.

Do not force any child to participate only encourage.

Learn the rules to better understand what you are looking at and commenting on.
